Our Solution



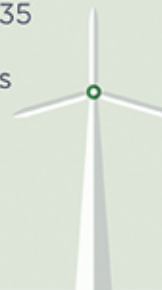
100% of the Consortium's housing portfolio to become sustainable by 2020 through appropriate green certification(s)
